fter three years at the helm of the Singapore Medical Association (SMA), Dr Wong Chiang Yin stepped down as President of the 49th SMA Council at the Annual General Meeting (AGM) on 5 April 2009 in the Alumni Auditorium. Dr Wong has been serving on the Council since 1995 and continues his term on the 50th Council as the 1st Vice President.

Taking over the leadership of SMA is Dr Chong Yeh Woei, who was 1st Vice President from 2006-2009, and was first elected to the Council in 1998. Dr Chong is a physician with the Singapore Medical Specialist Centre.

Dr Toh Choon Lai, an orthopaedic surgeon in private practice, was re-elected as $2^{\rm nd}$ Vice President.

The Council welcomed a familiar face, Prof Wong Tien Yin, MBBS (1992), MMed (Ophth), FRCSE, FRANZCO, MPH, PhD (Johns Hopkins). Prof Wong was previously elected to the Council for the terms 1994-1998 and 2002-2004, during which he was Honorary Assistant Secretary from 1995-1996; Honorary Secretary from April to June 1996; and Honorary Editor of the *SMA News* from 2002-2004. Prof Wong is presently Professor, National University of Singapore; Director, Singapore Eye Research Institute; and Senior Consultant, Vitreo-Retinal Service, Singapore National Eye Centre.

The Council also expressed its deep appreciation to Dr Raymond Chua, who retired from the Council after five years, during which he had served as Honorary Secretary from 2005-2008 and Secretary General of the Medical Associations of South East Asian Nations (MASEAN) from 2006-2009, as well as contributed to various SMA committees.

The Installation Ceremony for the 50^{th} SMA Council was conducted after the AGM on the same day, in the SMA Conference Room.
