The clinic will assist you with the following:

- confirm diagnosis and notify work-related cases to MOM
- manage the effects and complications from the toxic exposure
- conduct workplace assessments where indicated, and
- provide recommendations on preventive measures to employer and worker so as to prevent recurrence.

For other types of occupational or work-related conditions, you may refer to our other existing occupational health clinics. Patients will be seen by appointment only.
