Topic: Medical Practice and the Next ICE Age

Synopsis:

Doctors are trained and schooled in the good tradition of giving the best care to our patients. We are taught to “first do no harm”. Yet we are living in an age where expectations and resources vary widely. Sharing lessons learnt from working among poverty-affected communities, the speaker hopes to get us to think about practising Medicine as a science as well as an art in today's pluralistic society.

Dr Tan Lai Yong graduated from the National University of Singapore (NUS) in 1985. In 1996, together with his wife and one year old daughter, he moved to Yunnan in southwestern China, where he ran a village doctors training programme and worked with disabled people. Later, his family of four moved to Kunming, where he taught at Kunming Medical University and also led medical work in Bless China International, a non-governmental organisation based in Yunnan.

For his contributions in Yunnan, he received many awards, among them the China National Day Friendship Award for Foreign Experts (2004) and the Yunnan TV Good Citizen of Kunming Award (2007), and was also featured on Channel NewsAsia as one of the “Asians of the Year 2009”. He has also published a few books based on his Yunnan experiences, such as *Biting The Bamboo* and *Two Ears But Only One Mouth*.

He is currently studying full time at the NUS Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy, on a scholarship from the school.
