

THE FIRST INTER-HOSPITAL CONCERT

THE FIRST INTER-HOSPITAL CONCERT shall be held on 20 November 2010. This concert, which will be held at the Singapore Conference Hall, is organised by the Singing Doctors Society (SDS).

The Singing Doctors Society was formed in February 2007 under the leadership of Dr Timothy Lee, a neurosurgeon at Gleneagles Hospital. SDS is open to all doctors, their family members and related healthcare personnel. Its aim is to promote a sense of harmony and to spread goodwill through singing. The members are also encouraged to work together to help raise funds for charity.

Proceeds from previously held concerts by SDS have been donated to the following causes: viz. the Rainbow Centre-Balestier School, an orphanage in Sumba, Indonesia, Yong-En Care Centre, Forever Angels, a home for orphaned and abandoned children in Tanzania, needy HIV and poor patients in Tan Tock Seng Hospital, the cyclone victims in Myanmar and to Project HELP to aid the village of Bandipur in Nepal.

This year, the proceeds from this concert shall be donated to needy patients in four major public hospitals. Many patients are in need of not only medical help, but also financial and social assistance. Patients will benefit from donations to the following funds:

SGH - "SGH Needy Patients Fund"

TTSH - "Tan Tock Seng Hospital Community Charity Fund"

The first inter-hospital concert promises to be a fun-filled event with Dr Quek Swee Chong as the emcee for the evening plus performances by doctors from SDS – Dr Timothy Lee, Dr Chin Kin Wu (anaesthetist), Dr Sharon Low Huey Chin (general practitioner); from SGH – A/Prof Chan Yew Weng (Senior Consultant, Dept of Anaesthesiology), A/Prof Tay Sook Muay (Senior Consultant, Dept of Anaesthesiology), Dr Ng Bang Teen and Dr Adrian Ng along with many other doctors and paramedical staff from the five participating groups, the National University Hospital, KK Women's and Children's Hospital, Singapore General Hospital, Tan Tock Seng Hospital and the Singing Doctors Society.

Each participating group will compete as a team. Each team shall present one solo English song, one solo Chinese song, one solo song in another language and a song as a group in any language. Audience participation will be encouraged, as the winning team will be chosen by audience voting as well as by professional judges on a 50/50 basis.
