Who is eligible for a wish?

Children who are Singaporeans or Singapore PRs, aged from 3 to 18 years, and diagnosed with a life-threatening medical condition are eligible for a wish. We define a "life-threatening medical condition" as a progressive, degenerative or malignant one. Cancer, tumours, organ failures, and neurological conditions like muscular dystrophy and epilepsy are the most common conditions which beneficiaries suffer from. There is no household income requirement and 100% of the wish cost is funded by Make-A-Wish.

The most common misconception is that a wish is for terminally ill children. This is *not* true! Studies have shown that the wishes complement medical efforts, giving a positive and uplifting relief to the children and their families. So many of our Wish Children overcome their conditions and go on to lead happy and healthy lives.
